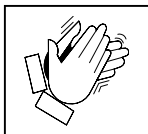
At the end of the fall semester we selected our new officers for the calendar year of 2002.

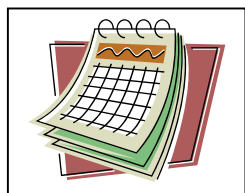
